

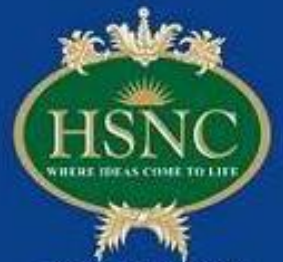

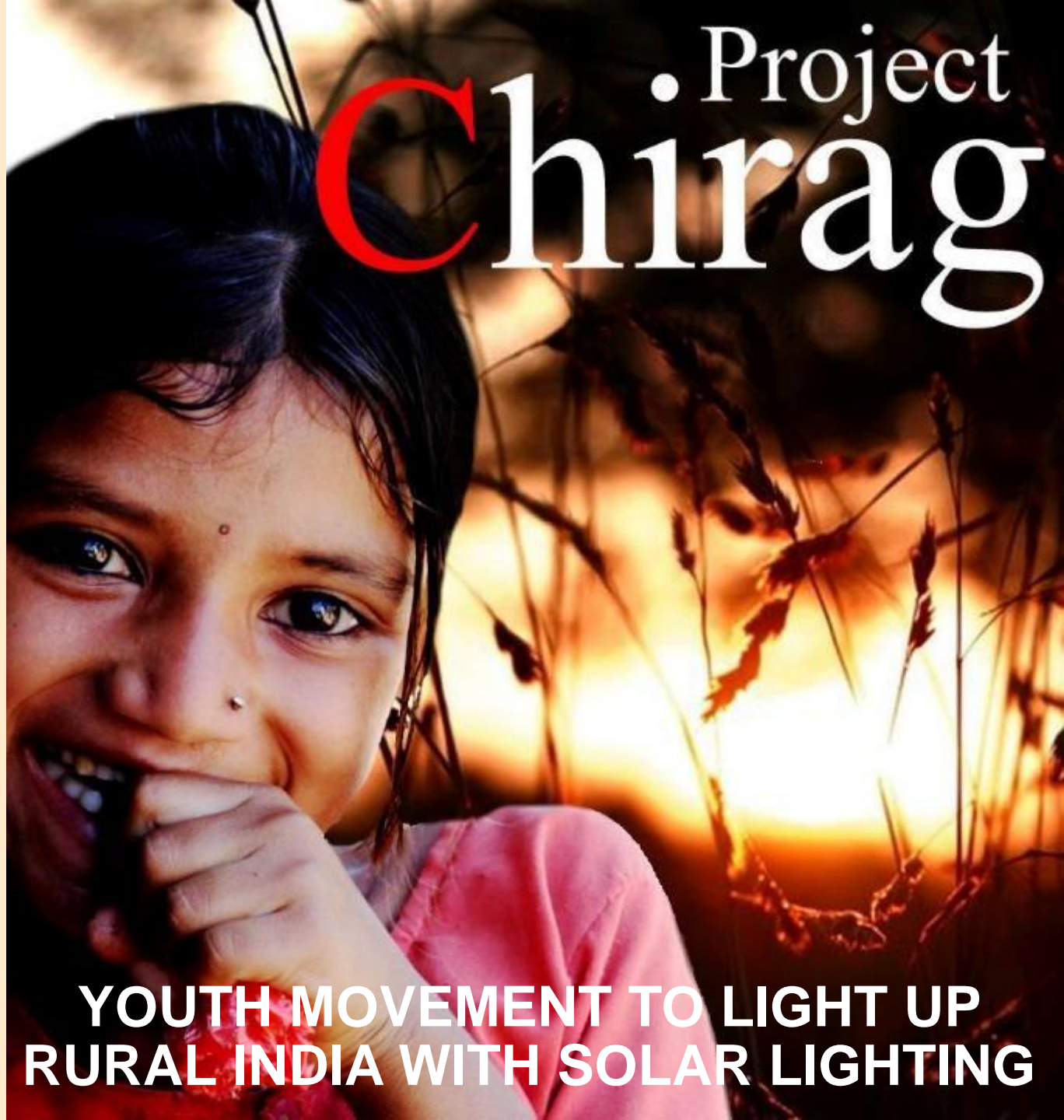

This year the women of the village were educated on the basics of sanitation. Sanitary napkins were distributed which are re-usable for a span of 3 years. The lives of 70 women were touched and encouraged to use hygienic sanitary napkins which would prevent life-threatening diseases.

Project Jalvruddhi – ENACTUS HRC

Project Jalvruddhi, is Enactus H.R. College's solution to the pressing water concerns of India. The aim is to primarily address two water issues.

- To combat contaminated water, water filters are provided at minimal cost to purify the water and make it suitable for consumption. Workshops for rural families are conducted to create awareness regarding water conservation and protection of water resources.
- To operate the whole project, a commission-based model has been devised. The villagers will be trained in respect of basic technical knowledge and communication skills for selling the, filters to villagers.

It is dedicated to revolutionize the manner in which water has been purified and utilized by the households of rural India since the olden times, and consequently empower the rural communities by providing avenues to financially sustain their families with increased income.

MUMBAI: A few months ago, Mohit Kataria, an MBA student, had organised a financial literacy camp for Akashi village on the outskirts of Virar, a Mumbai suburb. The village gram panchayat had banned plastic bags and asked residents to use paper bags instead, he said. Not long after the visit, Kataria along with some of his colleagues — from their college, Sydenham Institute of Management Studies, Research and Entrepreneurship Education (SIMSREE) — helped a group of women from the village start a paper-bag making business.

गेल्या चार-पाच महिन्यांत वसई, विरार व ठाण्यानजिकच्या १८ गावांमध्ये हा प्रोजेक्ट यशस्वीरीत्या राबवण्यात आलाय.

वॉटरव्हीलची कमाल

'इन्व्हेंट्स' या ग्रूपमध्ये सुमारे ५० विद्यार्थी काम करतात. 'जलवृद्धी' प्रोजेक्टअंतर्गत, 'वेलो' या संस्थेनं बनवलेली 'वॉटर व्हील' अत्यंत कमी किंमतीत महिलांना उपलब्ध करून दिली जातात. हे वॉटर व्हील म्हणजे दोन्ही बाजूंनी ढकलत नेण्याजोगी एक छोटी टाकी आहे. हंडे आणि कळशा उचलल्यामुळे मागे लागणारी दुखणी रोखणं यामुळे शक्य होऊ शकेल. आधी दिवसातून पाच-सहा

वेळा भरावं लागणारं पाणी आता या व्हीलच्या मदतीने त्यांना दोन वेळाच आणावं लागतं. या व्हीलमध्येच पाणी साठवण्याचीही सोय आहे हे विशेष.

'शुद्ध'चा डोस

पाणी शुद्ध करण्यासाठी 'व्हॉकहार्ड फाउंडेशन'नं बनवलेल्या 'शुद्ध' नावाच्या विशेष गोळ्यांचं वाटपही इन्व्हेंट्सतर्फे करण्यात आलं आहे. या गोळ्या पाण्यात टाकताच सुमारे अर्ध्या तासात पाणी शुद्ध होतं आणि त्यातले नको ते जीवजंतु नष्ट होतात.

रोजगार निर्मिती

या वस्तीतल्या स्त्रियांना घरबसल्या रोजगार उपलब्ध करून देण्याचं कामही इन्व्हेंट्सतर्फे करण्यात आलं आहे.

या महिलांना 'कॅनव्हास टोट बॅग' बनवण्याचं प्रशिक्षण देण्यात आलं आहे. या बॅगा बनवण्यासाठी लागणारं साहित्य त्यांना पुरवण्यात येतं आणि त्यांनी शिवलेल्या बॅगा कॉलेजबरोबरच कंपन्यांमध्ये विकल्या जातात. यातून मिळणार मोबदला या स्त्रियांना दिला जातो. पाण्याचा योग्य वापर करण्याबाबत जनजागृती करण्यासाठी हे विद्यार्थी या पाड्यांना वरचेवर भेट देतात. पाणी उकळवून पिणं, पोटात दुखल्यास दवाखान्यात दाखवणं, तसंच डेंग्यू, मलेरिया यासारख्या रोगांचा प्रतिबंध कसा करावा याबद्दल इथे विशेष जनजागृती मोहिमही राबवण्यात येते.

PROJECT INAAYAT – ENACTUS HRC

Project Inaayat is in collaboration with an international organisation Days for Girls. Inaayat is dedicated to strengthening girls' sense of dignity and self-esteem by making and providing sustainable menstrual hygiene solutions and health education.

The vision is to ensure that every girl and woman will have ready, feasible access to reusable hygiene supplies. The aim is to positively impact women and girls by providing them a menstrual hygiene kit which has Washable pads (made of two parts: a shield and a liner), Drawstring Bag, Panties (Premium Kit) and other essentials to ensure that each recipient's needs are met. The project has two aspects:

1. Manufacturing the Sanitary Napkins
2. Train the trainer model wherein the women conduct menstrual hygiene training and further train them to train more women.

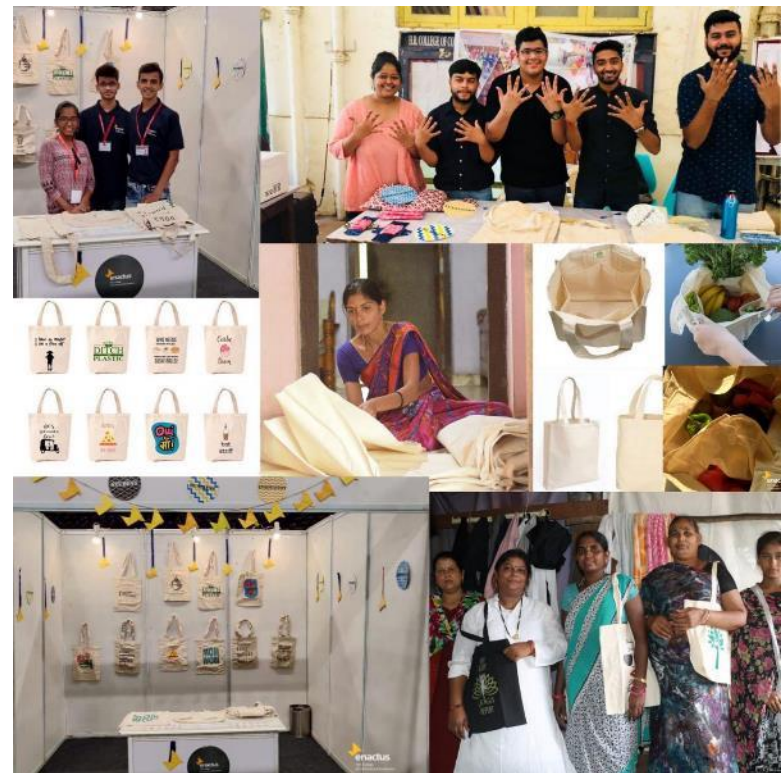

Aajeevika in Hindi, refers to 'lively-hood'. Through Project Aajeevika, employment is provided to the rural women of Maharashtra, thus increasing their family incomes and henceforth, enhancing their standard of living.

This project yields more confident and more self reliant women, consistently challenging the notion prevalent amongst rural India that women must be confined to the four walls of the house for their entire life. The women capitalising on their indigenous skills, improve their livelihood by stitching canvas tote bags which are available in varied trendy designs.

For the past two days, the teachers at HR College are reaping the benefits of a students' initiative to make underprivileged women self-sufficient. They are enjoying a variety of soothing treatment at a temporary spa set up on the college premises by the students and two women.

A year ago, the students of the Churchgate college helped Manisha and Reshma, residents of a Worli slum, obtain a beauty training course at the Schnell Hans Institute at Napean Sea Road.

While the trained hands are now offering relaxing treatments such as massages, manicure, pedicure and

threading, the students are promoting their skills through under the brand name Citrus Home Salon.

"When I heard about the initiative, the first thought that came to my mind was a relaxing session for our teachers. Teachers are usually a stressed lot. What better than a relaxing foot or back massage in between lectures," said HR College principal Indu Shahani.

Amid the hustle and bustle of the college premises, the Citrus Rejuvenation Lounge – with perfumed candles, soft music, dim lights and a hot cup of lemon grass tea – is something the teachers just do not want to miss.

Hindi professor Sheela Shahe said she rushed to the spa in the break in between two lectures. "The back and foot massage

sessions rejuvenated me for my next two lectures in the day. I wish we could get this done every day."

Under the business model, Manisha and Reshma both get a fixed monthly pay of Rs 5000 along with commissions, depending on the number of clients they attend to. Manisha, 32, a mother of three, said, "I am happy that I can now contribute financially to my family. I want to give my kids better education." Reshma, 22, said she gives her salary to her father for household expenses. Sama Jashnani, one of the brains behind the concept, said, "When we discussed the idea with Indu ma'am, she suggested setting up the spa. It feels great to be encouraged this way and to see Manisha and Reshma do such a wonderful job."
