HR students play 'bulls and bears' in classroom

College introduces 'a virtual stock market' on campus where students can trade in shares every day



Students say daily trading enables them to better their understanding of the stock market

A stare hard at their computer screen, monitoring the flickering figures. Then, as if on cue, the entire classroom computer class. It's a virtual stock market where first-year students essay their roles of builts and bears.

Since the University of Mumbai introduced, for the first time in India, the specialisation course in financial markets in July 2008, the H R three-year BCom course can now trade daily for five hours.

"We noticed that theory classes for students were very mundane. Even providing them with a facility to trade online on certain websites did not help much in improving their understanding of mar-

line trading experience will come handy for students who plan to become research analysts, merchant bankers or be associated with stock markets.

While many have taken up the specialisation course, other students of commerce who are not studying markets have also registered with the investment club that deals with the trading.

"We have only 60 seats for the specialisation course in the first year but for trading, we see as many as 150 students. Students from other courses like accounting and finance actively participate in it," Pradyuman Bajaj, president of the investment club and a final-year student, said.

The college has also provided for a customised software designed on the lines of the one used at the Bombay Stock Exchange.

Dr Heena Thakkar, lecturer from the financial market course said, "Students opt to become brokers, sub-brokers and investors as per their choice. They create the portfolios and list them. Actual trading goes own as per demand and supply. At the end of the session, the stock of capital and individual gains and losses is determined. Students thus learn the working of a real stock market."

She added that the college has tied up with stock brokers to teach students about the intricacies of trading.

"We are happy that the college has thought about this. Trading goes on from 9.55 am and continues till 3.30 pm. There is minute by minute fise and fall that happens in this virtual market which is akin to the BSE," said Harsh Modi, a student.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE VIRTUAL STOCK MARKET

- The market opens at 9.55 am every day.
- Students create portfolios as per their choice and create companies
- The companies are shown as listed on the sensex
- Trading happens as per demand and supply of shares of the listed companies
- At the end of the day, students take stock of the day's trading and the sensex is determined.
- It is compared from the previous day's trading to determine rise and fall in senses.

THE NEW SPECIALISATION COURSE:

The specialisation course in financial markets introduced by Mumbai University is a three-year-course and comprises six semesters with papers:

Principles of investment, financial accounting, environment of financial system, debt markets, commodities market, security

There are a number of new challenges emerging which many a times the CEO has to manage alone. He added that this was the point where the financial team helped the CEO to tackle the challenges faced. The finance team along with the CFO take over the problems and sort them out together. Today, the CFO's have to play four critical roles i.e. Operator, Steward, Catalyst and Strategist.



Transforming Finance: Blockchains, Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence



The program (in Association with **CIMA**) commenced with **Ms. Deepti Gupta** (Audit Leader and Risk Control Specialist at HSBC Bank) introducing how machine learning, artificial intelligence and blockchains are transforming finance. She stressed on importance of AI and robotics and elaborated their differences. Ms. Deepti Gupta busted the myth of blockchains only being related to cryptocurrency.

She described the use of data analytics in finance and in risk control and how cloud services lead to efficiency in working. She concluded the session by explaining how AI, Blockchains, Big Data and Cloud services are combined in various financial operations like inventory management, processing big data, tax processes and audits have become easier and more precise. She opened the floor for some questions and then CIMA took a quiz to test if the students understood everything. The session concluded with Ms. Bhakti Rane announcing the quiz winners.
