- 1. ISO 14001:2015 certification highlights the college's dedication to environmental management. By implementing efficient systems and processes, H.R. - 2. The "One-Day International Multidisciplinary Conference, India @100: Vision 40 trillion Dollar Economy," held on February 7, 2023, was conducted as a part of the Azadi ka Amrit Utsav initiative.
